
"The multicultural living and living happily were the bedrock of European nations which we have failed. Utterly failed."

Today, we all are aware of the burnings and killings of the innocent masses of the Palestine state. At the Gaza-border every day people are being killed by the Israeli government.




Fig # After 1948 the occupation of the Israeli Force.





Fig # After 1948


The brutal army of Myanmar conducted massive rapes, killings and burnt down all the houses of the Rohingya community
