

The Contribution of Sher-E-Barrol 2) A.K. Fazlul Hagne as the Releiver of the Peasants: A.K. Fazlul Hagne was conferred with the monikar of "Shep-E-Bangla" for the very neason of his role to emancipate the peasant commonity of East Pakistan during the 60s.
The contributions are Whe "Prajoi-Sattya Law on the Farmers?" In 1950, he invoked a law for the fair prights of the farmers of Bengal called the "Praja-Sattyn Law" which believed the preasants of their burden of debts and share of profits. Then 19th amendment of the constitution came on 18th September , 1991 and the government was lagain beinstated into a tapliamentary one. As a nesult the Resident became a menely titular figure to the executive bodies of the government.

Immunity Entitled to the President:

Under the profice of 51 of the Einsti-tution of the Republic the processent enjoys the following immunities
